- 1. Are you more thirsty for God than ever before?

  Ps 42:1 says, "As the deer pants for the water brooks, so my soul pants for You, God." NASB
- 2. Are you more and more loving? 1 Jn 4:7 says, "Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God." NASB
- 3. Are you more sensitive to and aware of God than ever before? Rom 6:11 says, "Even so consider yourselves to be dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus."

- **4.** Are you governed more and more by God's Word? 2 Tim 3:16, 17 say, "All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness; that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work." NASB
- 5. Are you concerned more and more with the physical and spiritual needs of others? Gal 6:10 says, "So then, while we have opportunity, let us do good to all men, and especially to those who are of the household of the faith." NASB

- 6. Are you more and more concerned with the church and her needs? Eph 5:25 says, "Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her." NASB
- 7. Are the disciplines of the Christian life more and more important to you? 1 Tim 4:7 says, ". . . discipline yourself for the purpose of godliness." NASB
- 8. Are you more and more aware of your sin? 1 Tim 1:15 says, "It is a trustworthy statement, deserving full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, among whom I am foremost of all." NASB
- **9.** Are you more and more willing to forgive others? Eph 4:32 says, "And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you." NASB
- 10. Are you thinking more and more of heaven and of being with the Lord Jesus? Phil 1:23, 24 says, "But I am hard-pressed from both directions, having the desire to depart and be with Christ, for that is very much better; yet to remain on in the flesh is more necessary for your sake." NASB
